- June, 2003** NanoHoldings LLC forms NanoComposites, Inc. ("NCI"), a Delaware C Corporation.
- July, 2004** Dr. Chris Dyke joins NCI as Chief Scientific Officer, and Professor James Tour, his mentor at Rice University, joins the NCI Scientific Advisory Board.
- September, 2004** Barry Drayson joins NCI as CEO.
- December 2004** NCI secures a license to the exclusive rights to 15 patents and patent applications relating to carbon nanotube ("CNT") functionalization from Rice University, Houston, Texas.
- January, 2005** Hydril LP, a Houston based oil products company, invests \$3 million in NCI.
- April, 2006** Hydril expands license rights to NCI technology.
- July, 2006** Dr. Jeffery Bahr joins NCI as Chief Scientific Officer.
- August, 2006** NCI is awarded \$1.5 million by Emerging Technology Fund of the State of Texas to commercialize elastomeric material applications.
- October, 2006** NCI joins the Houston Technology Center as a client. Mark Meyer joins NCI as VP, Corporate Development.
- December, 2006** NCI and Fenner Advanced Sealing Technologies (FAST), Humble, Texas, sign a joint development agreement for seal and gasket applications for the oil and gas industry.
- January, 2007** Global polymer manufacturer requests second state of an initial development agreement to proceed.
- June, 2007** NCI and FAST proceed to second stage of the Joint Development Agreement, which includes field trials of multiple products based on NCI technology.
